Minutes of Meeting

Attendance

The Holliday Band Parents Association met on Monday, June 16, 2008. The meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m. by HBPA President, Jimmy McCoy.

Announcements and Discussions

The minutes from the May meeting are posted online. No corrections were submitted. The minutes were approved.

Sue presented the financial report, noting a current balance of \$2991.30.

Concession stand: Misty Lee with Affiliated Foods was present. She said that, as an alternative to us buying concession stand supplies at Sam's, Affiliated Foods can provide us with virtually the same supplies for almost exactly the same price and deliver the goods to the concession stand each week. There would be no freight charge and no fuel charge. Nancy is going to get a list together so we can compare the prices offered by Affiliated to the prices we paid last year at Sam's, then we will vote on which vendor to use for concession supplies. It was agreed that if the prices are comparable it would be much easier for everyone to have the food delivered instead of someone having to go to Sam's each week. Affiliated Foods currently provides this same service to Iowa Park, Burkburnett and Wichita Falls schools.

Director's Update: Showcase is Tuesday, August 19. We will discuss this more at the July meeting. The directors submitted the wind ensemble recording to OPS. Three students medaled at the State Solo & Ensemble contest in San Marcos: Johnny Shoemaker, Jayme Onley and Kirsten Darnier (on piano). The tentative student count for band next year is 105-110, including 16 to 18 students in guard. The drum majors will be attending drum major camp next week. The directors are getting the music ready for next year.

DCI: Ear Level Communications is a new \$1000 sponsor this year. Ads for the program need to be submitted no later than 2 weeks before the show so that Ron and Sherri can get the program to the printer in time for the show. KMOC will again be donating some free airtime in exchange for a half page ad. Bo will email Liz Sanderson at KMOC with the script. Santa Clara Vanguard will be housed at Holliday this year. They are scheduled to arrive at 5 a.m. Monday morning. There was discussion again about selling tickets at SAFB. Mr. Folkening will check on that. Group military tickets will be sold for \$12 each if purchased before the day of the show. We will schedule a DCI meeting for committee chairs before the next full HBPA meeting. Notification of the date and time for that meeting will be sent out via email. Mel said that the New Car Dealers Association has again agreed to be a \$1000 sponsor. Ron Wilson said that he needs \$2000 to have the posters printed and advertising spots on Channel 3 and 6. Motion was made by Nancy Wagenfuehr to spend up to \$2000 for printing and advertising. Motion was seconded and passed unanimously.
