

# HBPA

May 16, 2011

The May meeting of the HBPA was called to order by President Lisa Douglass at 5:30 PM. There were 26 members present.

April minutes were posted online. Cathy Hoffman made a motion to accept the minutes. It was seconded by Jamie Alexander. Motion passed.

Tracy Scarber gave the Treasurer's Report. We still have one more payment of approximately \$11,000 for the Branson trip. Jacky Clark made a motion to accept the report and it was seconded by Helen Elms. Motion passed.

Drum Major Camp: It is customary for the HBPA to pay for the drum majors to attend camp at UTA. The camp this year is June 19-23. The cost is \$750. Senior Drum Major is Thad Douglass and Junior Drum Major is Brittany Schumann. Cathy Ahlhorn made a motion that the HBPA provide funding for the camp. It was seconded by Dawn Benham. Motion passed.

In order to make the transition from "old" to "new" officers in the future, and to insure that future correspondence for the HBPA gets to the correct person in a timely manner, Lisa Douglass made a motion that the HBPA secure a post office box at the Holliday post office. Angie Anderson seconded and the motion passed.

**DIRECTORS' REPORT:** Mrs. Hadderton thanked the HBPA for another great band banquet. Everything went smoothly and the DJ for the dance was great.

She handed out a new trip itinerary for Branson. We are leaving an hour earlier. The travel agent was able to get a good deal on a meal at Famous Dave's BBQ that Thursday night, but we have to be there by 4:30.

Due to the earlier departure time, there will not be a luggage check before we go. However, Mrs. H will explain to the students that rooms and luggage will be checked at any time during the trip if the need arises.

Dress for the trip is casual, but school dress code will be in place. The dinner cruise aboard the Branson Belle will be a little more formal. Nice school clothes/shoes will be OK. Talk to Mrs. H if you have any questions.

Students will be required to be in their rooms by 10 PM, when Mr. A. and Mrs. H will tuck them in and tape the doors. Lights out at 11. Chaperone shifts will be 10-12, 12-2 and 2-4 (if needed). There is a swimming pool at the hotel. Students **MUST** have an adult present if they choose to swim. For future reference, an adult is someone over the age of 30! No one is allowed in the rooms

of the opposite sex...not even in the doorway! There will most likely be an area at the hotel that we can designate a "meeting place" for those wishing to visit with friends. When we get to the hotel and the directors see the layout of the rooms, etc, some rules may need to be amended.

We will take 2 charter busses. Students have selected their bus and roommates. Parents riding the bus: Contact Mrs. H. if you do not need to be on the same bus as your child.

Chaperones will receive the following lists: trip roll, bus list, phone list, room list, and rules. Roll will be checked every time the busses load.

Silver Dollar City: students will be in groups of at least 4. Each group will be assigned a chaperone. They will determine check in times, meeting places, etc. while at the park. Everyone will get a meal (lunch) ticket for SDC, but snack money will be needed. There are some water rides and activities.

The Directors will continuously give information to the students about proper clothing, behavior, etc.

The departure time on Sunday morning has been revised. We will be leaving earlier to ensure that the seniors and parents can be back home in time to prepare for Baccalaureate.

There will be a meeting of incoming and outgoing officers at a date and time to be determined to ensure an easy transition of duties.

Cyndi Clark made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Angie Anderson. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned at 6:10 PM.
