**I. Call Meeting to Order:** meeting was called to order at 6:32 p.m. by Mindy Cuba, President.

All Region try outs will be Saturday, 12/1/18. Question was asked about chaperones for Spring trip to Branson-will they need to ride the busses with the students? Mrs. Seigler said that some chaperones may be needed to ride the busses.

b. Ways and Means:

Concession: Kristen Toulan and Chad Laffan were not present to give a report. Final clean-up of concession stand needs to be scheduled. All District concessions went well.

Fundraising: Carmen Roy reported that McAlister's did well. Next fund raiser is bowling on December 2. 16 lanes for 2-2 hour sessions. Each team needs at least one band member. Teams will need to be turned in by November 28. Suggestion was made to enlist band officers to help distribute flyers. Harvest food has not called back-Carmen Roy will continue to call. Decision was made to table idea of a fish fry for now. Carmen Roy suggested that extra band items might be sold at the Christmas concert (t-shirts, ornaments, cookbooks). She also said she may try to do a second printing of the band tshirts/hoodies. Other possible fund raisers include: baked potato dinner (Feb); Urban Air; Heff's;

Applebee's (March); a garage sale in the spring; Texas Roadhouse peanuts at baseball/softball games.

Hospitality: Noelle Marks reported that snacks were provided to band students for last 2 out of town trips. Flowers were given to Seniors on Senior night. Flyers should go out Friday for the Christmas parade float. A trailer has been obtained. Theme is Winter Wonderland. Cristie Crayton offered to send out a text requesting snow/trees/blue themed items for float decorations. Help will be needed to decorate float Friday 12/7/18 at the Ag barn. Parade is 12/8/18 at 10:00 a.m.
